

Accelerated BS in Sport Administration to MS in Sport Science

When can you start/declare program?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can apply directly to Accel program when they apply to LHU • Already enrolled students must complete a Change of Major form (do not have to be junior or have 3.0 to change into Accel program)
When can you start taking GR classes?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students must <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ be enrolled in the Accelerated program ○ be of Junior standing ○ have a 3.0 GPA or higher
How many GR credits can count towards my UG degree?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 12 GR credits can be counted towards both UG and GR
What if I am a student-athlete?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full-time status is determined by the type of class <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If taking all UG classes, it is 12 credits ○ If taking all GR classes, it is 9 credits ○ If taking combination of UG and GR, to be reviewed individually
When do I apply to the grad program?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During the semester you would complete UG degree requirements • Students will be accepted as “provisional” until completion of UG • Students do not need to apply to the grad program again. Graduate Admissions will retain their records until completion of UG
Do I need to submit a graduation application for my UG degree?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yes
When do I submit a graduation application for my UG degree?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For semester you will complete all degree requirements including the 120 credit minimum
When do I participate in UG graduation ceremony?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UG students can participate in UG graduation ceremony (Saturday) at the appropriate time according to Commencement Policies
When do I submit a graduation application for my GR degree?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the semester you will complete all GR degree requirements • A student may apply for UG and GR graduation during same semester
When do I participate in GR graduation ceremony?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UG/GR students can participate in the GR graduation ceremony (Friday night) at the appropriate time according to Commencement Policies.
Scholarships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four year scholarships are awarded for four year period. Taking GR classes or being coded as GR for financial aid will not effect this • UG students taking GR classes are still eligible for UG scholarships
Student billing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tuition will be billed at the class level • If the student is taking an UG class, s/he will be billed pro-rated UG rates • If the student is taking a GR class, s/he will be billed pro-rates GR rates • Students may be billed at two different rates if they are taking UG and GR in the same semester.

Financial aid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be classified as GR students for financial aid purposes after their third year of UG enrollment for financial aid purposes ONLY. • For other purposes – scholarships, grants, club membership including fraternities and sororities – students will continue to be considered UG.
Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UG SAP requirements are min 2.0 GPA, 67% completion rate and 150% time frame (180 credits) • GR SAP requirements are min 3.0 GPA, 67% completion rate and 150% time frame (45 credits)
Graduate Assistantship Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students enrolled in at least 9 credits GR classes are eligible for GA
What happens if I start taking GR classes but do not finish grad program?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GR credits taken as part of accelerated program will be counted towards UG even if student later decides to withdraw from GR program
