Policy for Naming of Facilities at Lock Haven University of Pennsylvania

1. Facilities may be named for persons or other entities such as corporations and foundations, if they have significantly influenced the lives of students and/or performed distinguished service, and/or made significant contributions to the University.
2. In the case of philanthropic recognition, the appropriate gift-to-project cost ratio will be determined by the Council of Trustees upon recommendation of the President.
3. Demonstration of outstanding service to the University shall be approved by the Council of Trustees upon recommendation of the President and/or the Chair of the Council of Trustees.
4. Substantial contribution to the development and destiny of the University shall be determined by the Council of Trustees upon the recommendation of the President and/or the Chair of the Council of Trustees.
5. The Council of Trustees shall approve the extent to which life and actions epitomize the ideas revered by the university community upon recommendation of the President and/or the Chair of the Council of Trustees.
