WHAT: ECED 225: BEGINNING LITERACY

- ◆ Define literacy as it relates to young children
- ◆ Demonstrate a variety of methods and strategies to help young children develop beginning literacy skills
- ◆ Complete integrated and/or theme-related activity plans appropriate for PreK-K children
- ◆ Describe differentiated instruction used to meet needs of special populations, including ELLs
