

LHU FIRST DAY ACCESS PROGRAM Q&A



What is the First Day Access Program?

First Day Access is a partnership between LHU and textbook publishers that allows students to have access to their course materials at the lowest possible price on the first day of class, with the charge included on your LHU student bill.

Are First Day Access Course Materials Digital?

Yes, all first day access books are eBooks. Some also include access code to online software.

How Do I Opt In?

You are automatically opted in when you register for a First Day Access course.

How Do I Opt Out?

Follow the instructions in the email you receive. If you deleted the email, you can also opt out through "Resources" in D2L once the course is open for the semester. You have until the end of the drop/add period to opt out.

How Do I Pay?

First Day Access course materials are charged to your LHU Student Bill.

Can My Financial Aid Help Cover the Cost of My Books?

Yes. Since First Day Access course materials are charged to your LHU student bill, your financial aid can help cover those costs, **if you receive a refund.**
